

Parish Magazine of Edgmond, Kynnersley and Preston Wealdmoors

There are ten editions of the magazine each year, two of which cover two months (August/September and December/January). 820 copies of each edition are printed and distributed free of charge to every household in Edgmond and to Harper Adams University. The remaining copies are sent to Kynnersley and Preston churches, to our link parishes of Tibberton, Great Bolas and Waters Upton, to various outlets in Newport such as doctors' surgeries and estate agents, and a few are mailed further afield.

Although the magazine started life as a church magazine covering the three parishes of the Edgmond benefice, we have developed the content to include very many secular items of interest to these parishes and beyond, so that it is now a more of a community magazine run by the church for the benefit of all. A copy of each edition is posted on the websites of St Peter's Church and Edgmond Village, but the paper copies remain much appreciated and in demand.

Volunteers from St Peter's Church take responsibility for editing the magazine, managing the advertisements, bundling and distributing copies (helped by other volunteers), and keeping the accounts. The printing is done at cost by the Church's Diocesan Office in Lichfield. Receipts from advertising make up a substantial proportion of the cost of production and we also benefit greatly from grants from the Parish Council and donations made by readers.

I have been the editor of the magazine for over 15 years and continue to welcome advice, suggestions and contributions so as to keep the magazine interesting and relevant to our readers.
