



**C2019/130 COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL**

**C2019/131 SOCIAL MEDIA**

Members confirmed their support for the need to communicate with the community on all matters of interest or concern and to share with the residents useful information (such as road closures) and good news stories (such as the upgrade of street lighting). After a lengthy discussion, it was agreed that Edgmond Parish Council would have a new Parish Council Facebook page for this purpose. Councillor Williams agreed to set this up and to act as the Admin to share stories provided by the Clerk, or taken from the Minutes of Parish Council meetings. It will be necessary to close down the existing page. It was confirmed that any communication received will be passed to the Clerk for response or to be added to a future appropriate agenda for discussion. It was agreed that this would be an initial pilot project for three months.

Members adopted the Social Media Policy.

**C2019/132 PARISH COUNCIL WEBSITE**

Thanks were extended to Mrs P Doherty for her continued support to ensure that the website is current and up to date.

This will be promoted, as it contains important information about the Parish Council and its procedures and policies, plus it is the archive for all Agendas and Minutes.

**C2019/133 MAGAZINE ARTICLES**

Members agreed to continue with the rota for magazine articles. A reminder will be sent confirming the date of the publication and the submission date. A rota was confirmed and will be circulated to all Members, for information.

**C2019/134 PARISH COUNCIL NOTICEBOARDS**
