

Report from St. Peter's Church 13th April 2021

Reverend Helen has kept the congregation together over the past 12 months with up to 3 zoom services a week for the 6 parishes (Preston upon the Weald Moors, Kynnersley, Tibberton, Waters Upton, Great Bolas and Edgmond.) Helen has also been taking Zoom services for the 3 schools.

The first service, in Church, this year, was on Easter Sunday and services will continue at 10.30 am on Sundays and are due to begin on Thursdays for Holy communion at 9.30 am, next week. Church is open all this week from 8am until 6pm for people to go in to give thanks for the life of service of HRH Prince Phillip.

Some services will carry on Zoom so that we are able to sing.

St. Peter's is to apply for Eco Church status particularly around the churchyard (being grade 1 listed we are unable to change to double glazing or cavity wall insulation, so we will do what we can)

Thank you to the Edgmond Wildlife Group for putting down the car park matting, so that we can use The Church Field for parking all year round (even though the entrance in and out is very dangerous)
