Every Member is required to register and disclose certain interests and those of their Partner where they are aware of the existence of such interests:-

Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation

Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain by you or your partner

Sponsorship

Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the Council) made or provided within the relevant period in respect of any expenses incurred by you in carrying out your duties as a member, or towards your election expenses.

This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.

Contracts

Any contract which is made between you or your partner (or a body in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest) and the Council —

- (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed;
 and
- (b) which has not been fully discharged.

Land

Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the Council.

Licences

HORSE

occupy land in the area of the Council for a month or longer.

Corporate tenancies

Any tenancy where (to your knowledge)—

- (a) the landlord is the Council; and
- (b) the tenant is a body in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest.

Securities

Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where—

- (a) that body (to your knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the Council; and
- (b) either—
- the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or
- (ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.



NOTES ON SENSITIVE INTERESTS

An interest is sensitive if you and the Monitoring Officer agree that its disclosure could lead to you, or a person connected with you, being subject to violence or intimidation. The nature of your sensitive interest will not appear in the published register of interests but it may be recorded that you have a sensitive interest.

I understand that I must write to the Monitoring Officer to tell him about any disclosure of a disclosable pecuniary interest made at a meeting which is not already included above within 28 days of making the disclosure.
