This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.</p>
<p><b>Contracts</b> Any contract which is made between you or your partner (or a body in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest) and the Council — (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and (b) which has not been fully discharged.</p>
